TURN IN YOUR COMPLETED FORMS

If you are applying for grades 1-8 we will notify you of acceptance after:

- All forms have been received
- An assessment by our Learning Specialist
- Recommendations from your child's former school have been received

If you are applying for Kindergarten:

- A student must be five years of age by September, 2010. Acceptance is based on specific criteria of developmental readiness.
- Turn in the completed application forms by January 29th.
- After we receive your completed packet we will schedule your child for a "Kindergarten Day." A "K-Day" is a mini-version of a typical kindergarten day condensed into one hour. On "K-Day" your child and other applicants will visit the Kindergarten classroom and participate in group play and small group activities. This enables the children to be observed and evaluated in a warm, informal setting. Following the "K-Day" session, your child may be called back for an additional formal assessment.

Completed Application Consists of the Following:

1. Application Fee - \$75.00 (Non-refundable) This is your testing fee.
2. A photo of your child (and if possible, parents)
3. Copies of the previous report cards (1st-8th Grade)
4. Copies of all Standardized Test Scores (1st -8th Grade)
5. Completed Application form and signed Application Statement
6. Completed Confidential Recommendation Form
7. Clergy Recommendation Form

Acceptance Procedures for students in grades 1-8:

After testing is completed and the parents have met with the Principal and the Pastor, the Principal will contact the parents by letter or by phone to discuss placement status.
